Providing Environmentally- Friendly Defenses Against Fire

Specialising in carved-recessed and flush solid fire-rated timber doors for residential as well as commercial needs, Shing Avenue Doors Pte Ltd offers Class 1A fire-rated doors, designed and patented by founder and Sales Manager Mr Philip Tiew, to a number of developers, contractors, architects and end-users in the local construction industry. Equipping every sort of building from public housing, condominiums, hotels, schools and hospitals to conservation buildings, the fire-rated door manufacturer takes pride in being one of only two companies in the local industry to be Green Label certified, acknowledging the environmentally-friendly means by which Shing Avenue Doors Pte Ltd assists its clients in meeting Singapore's Fire Safety Code of Practice.

Apart from the Green Label, Shing Avenue Doors Pte Ltd also has the SS332:2007 fire-safety standard as well as the bizSafe 3 certification, and is also the only fire-rated door manufacturer in Singapore to hold patents for its fire-rated timber doors in Singapore & Malaysia. In addition, Shing Avenue Doors Pte Ltd sends its doors to Wellington, New Zealand in order to conduct the Cyclic Movement Endurance Test, where each door sent for testing goes through 100,000 open and slam shut operation cycles to prove its reliability and durability. "Most other manufacturers do not put their products through this test, so this is a value-added service for our loyal customers," said Philip.

Shing Avenue Doors Pte Ltd also offers doors decorated with stained glass designs, each of which are the work of Mr Eugene Oen, the company's Glass Artist. A stained glass specialist who was trained in painting in the United Kingdom, as well as glass fusing and etching in the United States, Eugene is responsible for the design and provision of stained glass decorated to the clients' preferences, ensuring that the practical timber doors need not be drab affairs, and can instead complement the décor wherever they are installed.

The Starting Point

Having been involved in the fire-rated door industry for more than 30 years, Philip took the opportunity to observe and learn how such doors were designed and manufactured first hand, and eventually came up with one of his own. After much R&D, he decided to go with solid timber for the material of his door design. "Apart from being just as fire resistant as typical steel fire-rated doors if treated correctly, solid timber offered more flexibility in terms of design potential," Philip revealed.

"One must stay focused, and have the passion to do what you want to do."





Subsequently, after spending more than \$50,000 along with three and a half years to obtain a technical patent for his fire-rated door design, Philip brought his old childhood friend Eugene into the venture due to his skills in stained glass, and established Shing Avenue Doors Pte Ltd in 2006. "With him as a partner, I could diversify the business with the inclusion of stained glass decor, for the clientele who have stayed loyal to me all these years," Philip added.
